

## **Fall Creek Academy Required Reading by Grade**

Fall Creek Academy believes that reading is the core to all education. We begin our reading instruction in kindergarten with a mix of phonics and whole language instruction. Grades K-2 begin reading instruction from letter recognition to reading in complete sentences to short stories with some of our students ready for short novels prior to third grade. It is our expectation that ALL students are able to read chapter books at the beginning of third grade. Students who remain with us from third grade through graduation will read the required minimum of the 40 books listed below. Our students read one required book a quarter. As they enter high school the teacher does choose from a few different books but the choices are listed. All of the books used are from the approved Indiana Reading list. This is minimum reading. Teachers often add additional reading that students can select or that teachers use in other subject areas such as social studies. We believe that our students read far more than the minimum books required. The books listed are required reading in Language Arts Classes and of various genres. Each grade also has a theme approach as our students grow through literature.
